Houses on a corner suffer 40% of all break-ins. And you're more likely to be burglarized if you live close to a major thoroughfare, on a cul-de-sac, or on a dead-end street.

The Maxum deadbolt was tested against the standards set for auxiliary locks by the American National Standards Institute (ANSI) based on such criteria as ability to withstand kicking, prying, wrenching, hammering, sawing, and drilling attacks. MEDECO KNOWS HOW THIEVES BREAK INTO HOMES. AND HOW TO STOP THEM.

THEY BREAK THROUGH A CELLAR OR BACK DOOR
Medeco's SteelGuard dropbolt has a solid-steel locking bolt. Often a door will give way before this tough lock does.

THEY WRENCH OFF THE LOCK
The Maxum deadbolt's solid-brass collar spins under pressure so a wrench is ineffective.

THEY PICK THE LOCK
Double-locking action makes Medeco locks virtually pickproof.

THEY DRILL THE LOCK
The Maxum deadbolt and the Mortise and Rim cylinders are built with strategically placed hardened-steel inserts to provide the utmost resistance to drilling. Medeco's SteelGuard dropbolt can be supplemented by a Bodyguard solid-steel armored plate for the ultimate in protection against drilling, wrenching, and chiseling.

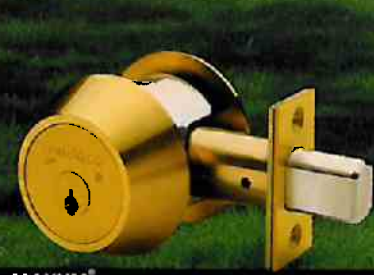
THEY HAMMER THE LOCK
The Maxum deadbolt's collar is made of solid brass and is secured with high-tensile steel bolts for maximum resistance.

THEY BREAK INTO STORAGE AREAS
Medeco's high security padlocks feature a pick and drill-resistant high security cylinder and give you the benefits of Medeco Key control.

THEY PRY WITH A CROWBAR
Maxum's hardened-steel bolt is surrounded by heavy-gauge tubular steel to resist crowbar attacks.

THEY KICK IN THE DOOR
The Maxum deadbolt's strike plate has a special design with 2" screws to anchor the strike directly to the frame of the building.

THEY BREAK GLASS AND REACH INSIDE TO UNLOCK THE DOOR
The Maxum deadbolt's optional "Childsafe" deadbolt has a special thumb-turn key that you can remove for additional burglary protection when you're away, or leave in when home to allow easy exit in emergencies.
